We need to retain our wonderful doctors in a new larger building.

The new plan is excellent, it would be good to have blood tests taken in the surgery instead of having to go to Bury

We would like to see more disabled parking allowed for. An idea to have parking for buggies with possible re-charge points would be very welcome. Signs in large print would also be welcome. Will it be a eco-friendly site with solar panels etc.?

Like & support the idea but concerned about the maintenance of a flat roof. Also think the building looks like containers of top of each other but happy if it does the job.

Our doctors provide a very importantservice to our community and need the space to continue to do this in our growing village. We are fortunate to have uch wonderful doctors in our surgery and ther vision for the future means they will be able to continue to provide high quality healthcare for us. We would benefit from many of their anticipated improvements.

As Hopton has already a piece of land available for a new surgery it would benefit people at Garboldisham a great del as many older people woud find it difficult to travel to Stanton so it would make sense to take up the facility as offered

There he been insuffiet consideration given to the proposal for a village funded new build surgery in Hopton

We keep hearing that there will be a prescription delivery service in Hopton but it ever happens - will it happen any time soon?

Would you consider a prescription collection service in Garboldisham?

If we don't drive, how are we supposed to get to & from Hopton-Stanton & return. Public transport is practical non-existent

Number one priority is access to GP appointment within 48 hours (preferable). Everythig else is nice but not essential Impressive vision. We hope the pubic consultation will continue.

Plan looks good but it is missing a footpath from the road to the entrance door for pedestrians and wheelchair users. It would be useful for another meeting to be set up after

NHS funding & planning permission granted as there could be valuable comments given on the nitty gritty of the design of the interior space.

Perscriptions - not able to supply some of the drugs needed which means we have to collect from a pharmacy in Diss or Thetford. Appointments - we have to wait approx a week - not enough doctors (part-time) to cover patients

I think the present system is not working: 1. Difficulty in getting appointments in good time 2. Prescriptions not always complete which means another visit to surgery or a visit to another pharmacy 3. parking 4. Are there enough doctors to cope with the amount of patients on your books?

The service provided by the GPs is very good currently - maintaining quick appointment times & availability is my priority. More nursing led services & phlebotomy may be helpful. I would be happy with option E or F.

Any new surgery needs to cater for the growing population. A green field site in Stanton is a solution. My preference is for Option F, with facilities for X Ray, Minor operations & rooms for visiting consultants. I don't believe smaller GP surgery facilities in Hopton would be viable

Concerned about the distance from Garboldisham to Stanton and the cost - a large percentage of the village are pensioners who find it difficult

Why are there two disabled parking spaces at the rear of the new building plan - is it possible to move next to spaces allocated at the side of the main entrance? Is it possible to have a new addition of a footpath for pedestrians entering from the road? Otherwise excellent layout & provision of services.
